Organic Heirloom Flower Seeds

1. Marigold, Sparky Mix \$4.50
A French marigold with orange, yellow and red pompoms. 12-14 inches tall.
2. Sunflower, Autumn Beauty Mix \$4.50
Decorative bright yellow and orange flower mix. 5 ft. tall.
3. Sunflower, Dwarf Sunspot \$4.50
Traditional large yellow flower with dark center. Good seeds for eating. 2 ft. tall.
4. Sunflower, Lemon Queen \$4.50
Vibrant light-yellow flower with dark brown center. 5 ft. tall.
5. Zinnia, Thumbelina Mix \$4.50
Colorful pompoms on compact plants; good for containers or boarder gardens.

Organic Heirloom Greens Seeds

1. Bloomsdale Long Standing Spinach \$4.00
Sweet, tender and mild; bolt resistant and easy to grow.

2. Dwarf Blue Curled Scotch Kale **\$3.75**
An early, hardy kale with curly blue-green leaves – flavorful.
3. Giant Red Mustard Greens **\$3.50**
Extra-large green and red leaves – cut and come again.
4. Lacinato Kale **\$4.50**
Known as dinosaur kale; dark green leaves with excellent flavor.
5. Organic Lettuce Blend **\$4.50**
A beautiful mix of easy-to-grow organic lettuces.
6. Red Rhubarb Swiss Chard **\$4.25**
Deep green leaves with ruby stems – mild and delicious.
7. Tennis Ball Lettuce **\$4.00**
Mini butterheads – tender, delicate and delectable.

Organic Heirloom Herbs Seeds

1. Basil Genovese **\$4.25**
Traditional pesto basil with large, dark green leaves and great flavor.
2. Chives **\$4.25**
A mild relative of the onion with edible purple flowers.
3. Cilantro **\$4.25**
Traditional Mexican herb, bright flavor; may self-seed.
4. Lavender Vera **\$4.25**
Scented purple flowers; great for tea, baking and potpourri.
5. Lemon Balm **\$4.25**
Natural mosquito repellent; delicious in teas and cool beverages.
6. Parsley, Giant Italian **\$4.00**
Traditional Italian garden parsley; good for eating fresh or drying.
7. Sage **\$4.00**
Silver-green leaves with purple flowers; delectable with poultry and veggies.
8. Thyme **\$4.25**
Wonderful scent with delicate purple flowers; great with poultry, fish and veggies.

Organic Heirloom Melon/Pumpkins/Squash Seeds

1. Hale's Best Jumbo Melon **\$3.75**
Large melon with sweet orange flesh and a netted rind.
2. Howden Pumpkin **\$4.75**
Orange Jack O' Lantern pumpkin with a tall shape and sturdy handle.
3. Jaune et Vertus Scallop Squash **\$3.25**
Scallop squash with green stripes and mild flavor. Harvest large or small.
4. New England Pie Pumpkin **\$3.75**
A small, sweet pumpkin with fine-grained flesh – perfect for baking.
5. Mountain Sweet Yellow Watermelon **\$4.50**
Large, sweet watermelon with firm deep yellow flesh. 20-35 lbs.
6. Sugar Baby Watermelon **\$4.00**
Small icebox watermelon with sweet red flesh, black seeds and a dark rind.
7. Waltham Butternut **\$4.25**
Extremely sweet squash with deep orange flesh; excellent keeper.

Organic Heirloom Tomatoes Seeds

1. Beefsteak **\$3.50**
Large, meaty red tomato; robust plant and vines.
2. Black Cherry **\$3.50**
A sweet black cherry tomato with rich flavor and deep color.
3. Cherokee Purple Tomato **\$3.50**
Large oblong tomato with bright flavor and deep color.
4. Matt's Wild Cherry Tomato **\$3.50**
Tiny, sweet cherry tomato and vigorous grower – loved by culinarians and kids.
5. San Marzano Paste Tomato **\$3.50**
Exceptionally rich red paste tomato. Firm with medium-sized long, thin fruit.
6. Yellow Pear Tomato **\$3.50**
Small, very sweet yellow tomato with amazing flavor.

Organic Heirloom Pepper Seeds

1. Early Jalapeno Pepper **\$3.75**
Medium hot pepper that turns red if left on plant; cool weather tolerant.
2. Mini Bell Pepper Mix **\$3.75**
Excellent yields of bright multi-colored peppers on medium-sized plant.
3. Sweet Chocolate Bell Pepper **\$3.75**
Medium-sized, brown-skinned sweet pepper with great flavor; fast grower.

Organic Heirloom Veggie Seeds

1. Black Beauty Zucchini **\$4.50**
Flavor-packed dark green zucchini; prolific, beautiful and delish.
2. Blue Lake Bush Beans **\$4.50**
Long, thin, straight green beans that grow on petite bush plants.
3. Detroit Dark Red Beet **\$4.50**
Traditional round beet with rich flavor. Harvest as baby beets or full-sized.
4. French Breakfast Radish **\$3.75**
Fast-growing, oblong red radish with white tips – mild, crisp and flavorful.
5. Golden Bantam Sweet Corn **\$4.75**
Traditional heirloom sweet corn with old-fashioned sweet, rich flavor.
6. Laxton's Progress Pea **\$4.25**
Short vines with plump pods and high yields. Sweet and delicious.
7. Little Finger Carrot **\$3.25**
Very sweet, bright and crisp; harvest baby or full-grown carrots.
8. Marketmore 76 Cucumber **\$3.75**
Wonderful slicing cucumber – juicy, crisp and sweet with few seeds.
9. National Pickling Cucumber **\$3.75**
Dependable grower producing the perfect crisp pickling cucumber.
10. Sugar Snap Pea **\$4.50**
Sweet, flavorful pods that grow on robust 5-6 ft. tall plants.
11. Rattlesnake Pole Bean **\$4.50**
Stunning green pole beans with purple stripes. Delicious and drought tolerant.
12. Waltham 29 Broccoli **\$3.50**
Compact heads with multiple side shoots; best planted in summer for fall harvest.
